# TRANSITION YEAR

The Transition Year Programme at Coláiste Éamonn Rís is a one year non-compulsory programme. The aim of the programme is-

- To provide a good academic basis for the Senior Cycle
- To develop teamwork through task orientated projects.
- To develop links between the school and the wider community
- To introduce students to a wide range of cultural and sporting activities.
- To help prepare students to become responsible members of society.

## BENEFITS OF DOING TY

- Students who complete TY, achieve significantly higher points in the Leaving Cert.
- It allows the students to sample various subjects in Leaving Certificate
- It promotes independent learning and students work as part of a team on numerous projects.
- Work experience offers insight into work that may appeal to the student.
- TY allows students to develop their personal and social skills outside classroom activities.





# ASSESSMENT

# WORK EXPERIENCE

- Each student will go on two different lots of work experience. This occurs on a Monday. So for two of the timetables in TY, the students will have a 4 day school week (Monday will be work experience)
- The student organises the work experience (keep in mind some employers will need the student to be vetted).
- Student will give employer our schools insurance policy, child protection policy and a letter from the school indicating the dates of the placement.
- If students want to do a week block work experience, that is allowed but students have to let me know and still will have to get the work experience for the Monday.
