Additional Subject - LCVP

- Leaving Cert Vocational Programme
- Grading Pass, Merit, Distinction (66 points = H4)
- Language exempt students 7th subject
- An additional Subject-8th Subject
- Two classes per week (Computer room) (Usually on line with Religion, which is non-exam)
- Preparation for world of work:
 - Work Experience
 - Enterprise Education
 - Reports
 - Interview
 - Exam in May

65 - 79%	46	Mark
50 -64%	28	Pass

Making a Wise Choice

- What subject is your child most interested in?
- What subject are they likely to be best at?
- What subjects will they need? Irish, Maths, English, Language etc.
- Balanced choice of subjects projects, workload, etc.

How to Choose

- Know what you want to do Research and choose accordingly (Reach+ - World of Ed., LC Subject Choice, Presentations)
- No idea what you want to do- Include a Science, a Business, and a Third Language
- Talk to teachers, family, friends
- Friends Subjects Avoid choosing a subject just because a friend is doing it

Different Stages of help Students receive for Subject Choice

- ► CAT's Aptitude Test
- REACH+ Interest Profiler Test
- Career Guidance Classes Course & career research
- One to One Guidance Appointments

3 main hurdles to Third Level Education (Entry)

- Matriculation Requirements / College Entry Requirements/Basic Entry Requirements
- Faculty Subject Requirements (Need a certain subject and grade)
- 3. Points (Best 6 in one sitting)

MATRICULATION

- > All colleges set down minimum entry requirements
- In most cases these specify ENGLISH and MATHS at a certain grade
- Recognised colleges of NUI require almost all applicants to have passed IRISH and a LANGUAGE from their matriculation programme
- There are always exceptions to this so students need to do their own research!


What You Need for Third Level



College (or Basic) Requirements.

6 subjects - 2 at Higher (H5) and 4 at Ordinary (O6) for <u>majority</u> of Level 8 Honours Degrees

5 passes (06/H7) in Leaving Certificate including Maths and English for Level 6/7 courses



+25 Bonus points for H1-H6 maths

LCVP link modules Distinction 66 Merit 46 Pass 28

COLLEGES REQUIRING MODERN LANGUAGE

- N.U.I. Colleges and NUI Recognised Colleges Only -UCC, UCD, NUIM/MU, NUIG, RCSI (Not all courses anymore!)
- Shannon College of Hotel Management & St. Angela's College Sligo (Home Ec.)
- Not a requirement for every course students should use the filter on Careers Portal to see what courses need a language.
 - Modern Language required for Cadets in Army






- Two preferences on at the same time.




Time Frame

- Each student will receive notification of their subjects a few weeks after this date.




