Wexford CBS Junior Cycle Exams – End-of-Year Arrangements 14th May 2025

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

As we approach the end of the school year, I would like to bring a number of important matters to your attention regarding Third-Year students and the Junior Cycle Examinations.

1. End of Classes and Supervised Study

Classes for Third-Year students will conclude at **3:45pm on Monday, 26th May**. Supervised study will be available for all Third-Year students on the following dates:

- **Tuesday, 27th May:** 8:50am – 3:45pm
- **Wednesday, 28th May:** 8:50am – 3:45pm
- **Thursday, 29th May:** 8:50am – 2:45pm
- **Friday, 30th May:** 8:50am – 12:00pm

Students may book a place by contacting **Mr. Howlin** via Microsoft Teams or in person by **Monday, 26th May**. Alternatively, you may email him directly at dhowlin@wexfordcbs.ie.

2. Junior Cycle Examinations

The Junior Cycle exams will begin on **Wednesday, 4th June**.

- Students must be in attendance by **9:00am sharp** on the first day of exams.
- For all other exam days, students should arrive **at least 15 minutes before** the start of each paper.
- The full exam timetable is available on the school website and at www.examinations.ie. We recommend printing a copy for easy reference.

3. School Uniform

Students are required to wear **full school uniform** while attending Supervised Study sessions and all Junior Cycle examinations.

4. Subject Level Changes

Any student wishing to change the level of a subject (e.g. from Higher to Ordinary) must submit a **completed Level Change Form**, signed by both a parent/guardian and the relevant subject teacher, by **Friday, 30th May**.

Please note: Level change requests will not be accepted on the day of an examination.

5. Uniform Donation – Sustainability Initiative

As part of our ongoing sustainability efforts, we welcome donations of **clean, gently-used**

school uniform items (e.g., shirts, jumpers, ties). Donations of uniform items will be accepted from **Tuesday, 17th June to Friday, 20th June**, and may be dropped off at **school reception**.

6. Book Lending Scheme

Students are reminded to return all books given under the book lending scheme (**English, Maths, Gaeilge**) before the end of May to facilitate the redistribution of books to other students in September.
